First Steps Report- David Lisk

1. Nurse Family Partnership
 - a. Interviewing Nurses and Supervisors now. Looking to have them hired in the coming weeks.
 - b. Training will be done as soon as feasible and then the formation of the Community Advisory Board.
 - c. Reconnecting with community partners to establish the referral network will begin with the hiring of the Nurse Supervisor.
2. Early Childhood Conference
 - a. Kimberly P. Johnson was our Keynote Speaker this year at our Conference on March 19.
 - b. We had approximately 165 attendees to the conference this year.
 - c. Survey results are very positive regarding the Conference as a whole as well as the presenters.
 - d. We'll begin planning our 2017 Conference in the coming months.
3. Countdown to Kindergarten
 - a. Making preparations for CTK this summer with all four School Districts.
 - b. We plan to serve approximately 150 children and their families this summer.
 - c. We plan to co-host the CTK Celebration in downtown Rock Hill on Thursday August 4, 2017, a dinner for our families from 4-5 and then a County wide Celebration from 5-7 for all rising Kindergarten children.

Parenting Partnerships Report- Jane Culp

The LEAP Family Education Program has had a busy Spring Semester. In addition to our **home visits**, we have had nine **Parent-Child Activities groups** including the following themes: January- Pajama Party, February- Dinosaurs, and March - Froggy Friends. Each of the nine sessions had an average of 20 children who along with their parents participated in music, literacy, art, math, and motor activities.

In February LEAP sponsored 4 **Parent Discussion Groups**, two at Riverview Elementary and two at Fort Mill Elementary. The topic was "Ways to show your child love". We explored ways to invest in your child without spending much money. Each session was followed by a Valentines celebration with the 4K students. Over 100 parents and grandparents participated in the discussion groups.

We graduated our first class of parents in the **Parenting Partners course**. This course included parents with students at Riverview Elementary. We used the *Practical Tools for Positive Parenting* curriculum and met monthly during this school year. The parents from this group will lead their own parent groups through the same course in the fall.

The LEAP program organized and helped conduct the **4 year old screening** for the Fort Mill School District on April 14 and 15. 114 children attended the event and were screened in motor, concepts, and language development. Hearing and speech was also evaluated. The Lions Club provided a vision screening for each

child. Every parent participated in a conference with a certified early childhood teacher to review results of the screening. The parents were also given suggestions for activities to do with their child and a book to keep.
